- Set appropriate objectives and targets to meet statutory obligations and improve sustainability covering all THNSW activities and sites
- Develop procedures and plans to help us achieve our objectives and targets
- Collaboratively review and update our environmental plans:
  - When scheduled
  - As required following an incident investigation (either internally or externally)
  - When changes in statutory or contractual obligations, or technological improvements occur
- Communicate changes and updates with all workers and ensure relevant training and induction documents are updated
- Carry out scheduled audits and reviews of compliance with our plans
- Assist the sector in developing and implementing appropriate targets and objectives to meet their statutory obligations and improve their sustainability
- Respond quickly and positively to any incident or potential incident to minimise the impact on the environment
- Record, investigate and report incidents or potential incidents that cause or may cause environmental damage
